Where there is demand, there is Human Trafficking

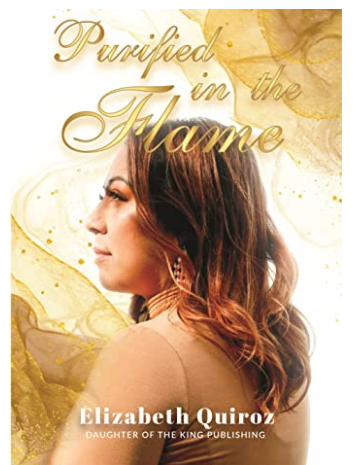
Learn to recognize the signs
